BULLDOGS WELCOME GOLDEN FLASHES

BULLDOGS WELCOME BACK GOLDEN FLASHES

Top-ranked Georgia (3-0) returns to Dooley Field at Sanford Stadium Saturday as Kent State makes its first appearance Between the Hedges since the 1998 season opener. The Golden Flashes (1-2) began this year with an extended road trip, falling to Washington and then losing to No. 7 Oklahoma before posting a big home win over Long Island. Meanwhile, Georgia has been very impressive in dismantling No. 11 Oregon in Atlanta, blanking Samford in Athens and crushing South Carolina in Columbia. Georgia has outscored its opponents 130-10 in Kirby Smart's seventh season at the helm.

The Bulldogs lead the nation in Scoring Defense, allowing 3.3 points a game. South Carolina managed to score the first touchdown against the Bulldogs this season, and it came with 53 seconds left in the contest to provide the final of 48-7. Last Saturday, Kent State picked up its first win of the season with a 63-10 rout of Long Island. It was the fourth time that the Golden Flashes have topped 60 points under coach Sean Lewis who is in his fifth season in Kent. The Golden Flashes like to run the football and rank 23rd nation-

ally with 221.3 rushing yards a game. Georgia is allowing only 83.7 yards a game on the ground and that is good for 20th nationally.

While Georgia ranks second in the SEC in Total Offense (532.3 yards/game), the Bulldogs are averaging an SEC best 7.9 yards per play with senior quarterback Stetson Bennett at the controls. He is completing 74 percent of his passes, and the Bulldogs rank third nationally in Passing Yards a game at 376.7.

The Bulldogs are averaging 43.3 points a game, and the school record in a season with at least 12 games is 41.3 set by the 2014 squad. Georgia's 2021 national championship team averaged 38.6 points a game and had the nation's top scoring defense at 10.2 points a game.

Georgia has been ranked No. 1 or No. 2 in 17 of the past 19 Associated Press (AP) polls, with the other two weeks at No. 3. The Bulldogs began the 2022 season ranked No. 3 and moved up to No. 2 after the opener. Georgia now is No. 1 for the second straight week.

Back in 1998, Georgia registered a 56-3 win over Kent State. The game featured a 40-yard touchdown strike on the third play of the day as freshman

quarterback Quincy Carter connected with future NFL Hall of Fame standout Champ Bailey. The All-America athlete started on offense, defense, and special teams. Carter became the first Georgia freshman to start the season at quarterback since Johnny Rauch in 1945. He finished 12-of-16 for 235 yards and three scores.

NOTABLES FROM GEORGIA'S WIN OVER SOUTH CAROLINA

- The Bulldogs posted their largest margin of victory against the Gamecocks, posting a 41-point win. The previous best came in the first meeting in 1894, a 40-0 shutout in Columbia. Georgia leads the all-time series with USC 54-19-2 including 6-1 under Kirby Smart.

- Freshman tight end Oscar Delp made sure his first catch was a memorable one as he hauled in a 28-yarder from Carson Beck for a touchdown.

- Georgia picked up 14 points off three interceptions. For the year, the Bulldogs are +6 in Turnover Margin and that ranks fourth nationally. The Bulldogs have scored 31 points off six turnovers this year.

• Top-ranked Georgia is one of only three teams in the FBS to allow only one touchdown this season, joining Iowa and Ole Miss. The Bulldogs lead the nation in Scoring Defense at 3.3 points a game while the Hawkeyes and Rebels are tied for second at 4.3.

• The Bulldogs have won 13 straight games on Dooley Field at Sanford Stadium. The Golden Flashes, winners of 10 straight at home, were picked to finish first in the MAC East by the league coaches and second in the division by the media in pre-season polls.

• Kent State only trailed Oklahoma 7-3 at the half and then lost 33-3. Still, they were the first group-of-five team to hold the Sooners scoreless in a first quarter since 2013.
